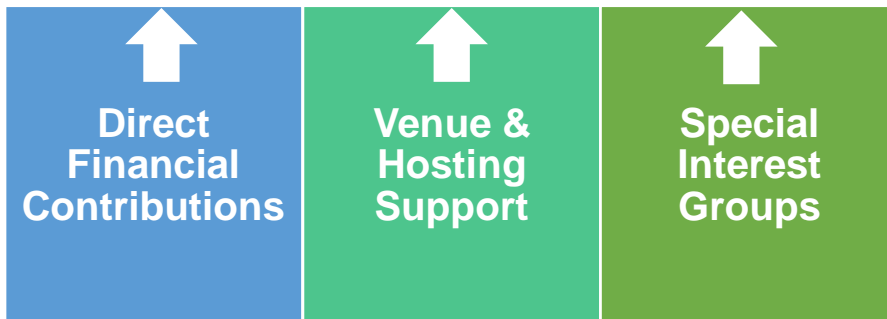


SPE London Section

Ways in which your business can support SPE London

SPE has 3 main avenues that support can be delivered:-

1. Through traditional direct financial contributions which are generally of 12months duration,
2. More commonly now some businesses prefer to offer venue and event hosting support which is still a valuable resource,
3. SPE London has a number of active and successful Special Interest Groups (SIG's) that offer businesses the opportunity to partner on specific industry themes.

Benefits from Supporting SPE London

- The SPE is a well recognised brand within the oil and gas industry. Businesses can leverage their support in many other communication outlets,
- The section digital platforms, monthly events and SIG events offer visibility to a wide audience including members and non members,
- Business logo's are prominently displayed on the section website, bi-monthly E-Magazine, during SIG and monthly evening lecture events,
- Businesses can demonstrate their commitment to Social and Corporate Responsibilities as a consequence of partnering on shared topics of interest,
- The section offers complementary access to monthly evening or continuing education events. 4 tickets per £1000 of financial or equivalent support.

How can financial support be delivered?

- Annual financial support starts at £1000 and runs from January to December,
- Supporting a specific evening lecture program where a business is presenting or wishes to be associated with a particular theme is £500,
- Venue support & hosting is taken on an individual case and is usually provided to help an SIG run a particular themed event
- SIG's have a number of well respected annual events that need support to ensure their success. Support for these events can be venue and hosting but could also include promotional materials and 3rd party services.
